Our programs specialize in helping our community and we take great pride in them. We hold special events multiple times a year to distribute Safety Vests, Safety Bags (includes daily essentials), Reflective decals, Wheelchair flags and many other donated items. We focus on supplying safety items to the homeless community and to those who have to cross dangerous roadways, especially at night. Our goal with this program is to increase visibility upon the homeless people who are at risk of accidents caused by unaware drivers.

We also provide hot meals for Thanksgiving along Colfax and Teller and have a Holiday Sock program.

Our continuance of these programs is instrumental in our mission to help the Colorado homeless population.



From February 10th - March 10th we are raising funds to purchase Wheelchair safety flags and reflective decals for our unhoused community. 
