As you well know, Colorado has seen record-breaking COVID-19 case counts and hospitalizations. Both our cases and our hospitalizations have exceeded our highest levels we experienced in April. We've entered a new and challenging chapter of the pandemic, and to save lives and keep our communities open we must act now.

That is why I've announced that state employees in Level Orange and Level Red counties will work remotely, except for essential personnel working in critical government functions who cannot perform job duties remotely. I'd like to ask you to join me in encouraging businesses in Level Orange and Level Red counties to have employees work remotely during at least the month of November as well.
